Mountadam Vineyards was established in 1972. The fruit utilised in this wine is from an area of Mountadam Vineyards eastern vineyard planted in 2001. The vines are planted at 450 meters above sea level.

Winemakers Note

The wine has a vibrant red colour on release. It has blue fruits, spice, cedar and a subtle undertone of blueberry aromas on the nose. The palate has blueberry and dense blackberry flavours with an underlying liquorice root character. The wine has an underlying spiciness and supple long tannins.

The fruit was harvested in mid April 2017. The parcels were fermented in 8T fermenters. The fermentation was maintained at 26^{°C} and malolactic fermentation was carried out in the fermenter. The parcels of wine were matured for twelve months in French oak barriques (30% new barrels, 20% 1-2 year old barrels, 40% older barrels). The wine can be enjoyed young but will reward careful cellaring for up to and possibly beyond 2027.
